

Policy Title: **GENERAL AND ACADEMIC BEHAVIOR**

Fox Valley Technical College believes in creating and maintaining a learning environment that values academic excellence, institutional integrity, justice, equity, civility and diversity. The College is committed to the academic and personal development of all students and requires the behavior of all students to be compatible with the mission and values of the College. Students are required to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times while attending all College sponsored activities, both on or off any district campus consistent with College policies and procedures and federal, state, and local laws.

Students should be aware that there are different policies and procedures that guide different types of misconduct. This policy sets forth general conduct expectations for behavior and academic situations, and directs students and staff to the General Behavior Code of Conduct and the Academic Code of Conduct for specific procedures. Excluded from the policies and procedures referenced in this document are issues related to sexual misconduct (see Sexual Misconduct Policy and Sexual Misconduct Procedure).
