FVTC Student Satisfaction Survey

- Conducted every two years in November
- Gathers feedback from students in program courses
- Survey instrument = Ruffalo Noel Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory
 - Online format
 - 113 questions
 - Participants rate each item on importance and satisfaction (scale of 1-7, 7 being the highest score possible)
 - Option to provide comments
 - Includes demographic items (gender, age, program, etc.)

Pros/Cons of an Online Format Versus Paper Format	 + Online students had the opportunity to participate + Staff did not need to take class time for students to complete the survey + The survey was mobile-friendly - Lower response rate than the in-person, paper format - Less comments than the in-person, paper format
