Each year, the FVTC Foundation provides scholarships, emergency assistance grants and program support to help our students succeed.

Starting Point is just one innovative program supported by the FVTC Foundation. This two-generation workshop is for women from low-income households and their children. It helps them determine the barriers they face to enrolling at FVTC and prepares them for success. At the same time, their children receive high-quality early childhood education which builds a strong foundation for future school readiness.



Since 2017, 104 women and 98 children have benefited from Starting Point, with 77% pursuing post-secondary education or working toward their GED.

Providing Help & Hope

When Zachery needed a car repair the week of finals, he had no idea where to turn. He shared his situation with a faculty member who suggested he apply for a Seeds of Hope emergency assistance grant. The grant covered the cost of the repair and allowed him to complete the semester as he commuted from Waupaca.

"If it wasn't for the Seeds of Hope grant, I would not have made it to my finals and I don't know what would have happened. I am so grateful." Zachery is enrolled in the Substance Use Disorder Counseling program and plans to work as a counselor in recovery.

When a student receives a grant, they are asked to pay it forward by doing something for someone else. Zachery helps others by sharing his own experiences and recovery story, and by offering his counseling skills to those who may not be able to afford specialized treatment or programs.

Seeds of Hope is the largest emergency assistance fund held at the FVTC Foundation. Students can receive up to \$500 for rent, utilities, car repairs, medical bills or other expenses to help them stay in school.
