

English Examination Exemptions

- Graduate from a U.S. High School
- Have earned a "C" or better in a university level English composition course (ESL does not qualify).
- Speak English as a native language. The following countries are automatically exempt:
 - Antigua & Barbuda
 - o Australia
 - Bahamas
 - o Barbados
 - o Belize
 - o Bermuda
 - o Bahamas
 - o Canada (except Quebec)
 - o Cayman Islands
 - Dominica
 - o Fiji
 - o Grenada
 - Guyana
 - o Ireland
 - o Jamaica
 - Kiribati
 - Liberia
 - Marshall Islands
 - o Micronesia
 - New Zealand
 - Solomon Island
 - South Africa
 - St. Kitts and Nevis
 - o St. Lucia
 - o St. Vincent and the Grenadines
 - o Trinidad and Tobago
 - United Kingdom

Applicants who have not met these requirements, but have high SAT/ACT reading and/or writing scores can petition to waive the English Examination requirements.
