If there is no score listed in the Minimum Scores Required column, students that score below Reading 54, Sentence 83, and Arithmetic 50 are encouraged to complete Program Prep in deficient area, but it is not required.

If testing scores are above the required minimum scores for the program, then the testing portion of the application process is completed. If necessary, please complete any additional required items for admission to FVTC and/or intended program.

If scores do not meet the minimum required level, you must successfully program prep classes in the deficient area. These classes will provide the foundation to help you succeed as you continue your education.
