Fox Valley Technical College is required, in certain circumstances, to verify information that was provided on the FAFSA. To be eligible for federal student aid, a student must have a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent, or be beyond the age of compulsory attendance and meet the criteria for homeschooled students.

## You must submit proof of one of the following to the financial aid office in the following ways:

- 1. <u>High School Diploma:</u> (this can be from a foreign school if it is equivalent to a U.S. high school diploma)
  - A copy of your final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
  - A copy of the student's final high school transcript that shows your graduation date.
  - For a student who has graduated early and has not yet received a final transcript or diploma, a form will need to be requested from the financial aid office to be completed by the high school principal or guidance counselor confirming you are no longer enrolled.

## 2. Recognized Equivalent of a High School Diploma:

- An official GED or HSED certificate from the Department of Public Instruction (DPI)
  - If you do not have the original, you can request a new certificate from the DPI. Please have this document sent directly to you. You will then need to bring the certificate into one of the offices so that a copy can be made.

    - There is a \$15 Fee to obtain your diploma, certificate, or transcript
  - If you cannot obtain verification from WI DPI, please contact the financial aid office.
- An official academic transcript indicating completion of at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree

## 3. Homeschool Credential:

 A transcript or the equivalent signed by your parent or guardian which lists the courses you completed and provides a statement that you successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting
