How to Request an IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter

What is an IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter?

An IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter provides proof that the IRS has no record of a filed Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ for the year you requested.

Non-Tax filers can request an IRS Verification of Non-filing of their 2020 tax return status, free of charge, from the IRS.

Online at https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript. NOTE: This is typically not available if you have never filed taxes in prior years.

- Click "Request Online" (If at any point, you cannot validate your identity for example, you cannot provide financial verification information or you lack access to a mobile phone you may use Get Transcript by MAIL option).
- > Follow instructions for creating an account or log in.
- > Select "Verification of Non-filing Letter" and in the Tax Year field, select "2020".
- If you choose the by "Get Transcript by Mail" option, the address you enter must match the address already on file with the IRS exactly. It is typically the address on your most recent tax return.
 - How to fix address matching problems when ordering online:
 - The address entered must match the address already in file with the IRS exactly.
 - Spelling out the word "street" rather than using the abbreviation "st" can be enough to cause an error.
 - Addresses in the IRS system are auto-corrected through a post office program and may not match
 what you put on your tax return. Go to www.usps.com, click on "Quick Tools," then "Look Up Zip
 Code" to get the standardized version of your address.

> Call 1-800-908-9946 to receive the transcript by mail to the tax filer's IRS address of record within 5 to 10 calendar days.

Paper Request Form 4506-T – The IRS is not processing paper request Forms 4506-T at this time.

In some instances, the IRS may provide the tax filer with an IRS Form 13873. Any version of IRS Form 13873 that clearly states the form is provided to the individual as verification of non-filing or states the IRS has no record of a tax return is acceptable documentation of non-filing.
