We support children by providing a safe and healthy place to learn foundational skills and build self-reliance. With staff trained to keep your child safe, and programmed drop-in care to keep them active, go take some time to relax and focus on your "you" time!

Information/Requirements

- Parenting Students must be enrolled in a class or working towards obtaining their GED or HSED.
- Parenting Students must live in Calumet, Waupaca, or Outagamie counties or the communities of Neenah/ Menasha.
- This is a pilot program funded by a grant from the Bright Idea Fund within the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region. We are looking for motivated students making progress in their education.
- Drop-in care is offered to children ages 6 weeks to 6 years old (*7 years at select locations, see back for details).
- Each child would receive up to 8 free hours of care per week, with the maximum of 5 hours per day.
- Parents may leave the building if they utilize the Appleton Downtown or Apple Creek YMCA Play & Learn Centers only. Other YMCA locations have free Wi-Fi and work stations for students to stay on-site to attend on line or virtual classes, or do their homework, while their child receives care at the Kids Corner.
