*This transfer evaluation was completed 4/28/16 by Mindy Johnson (Wisconsin representative) and does not reflect Franklin’s 2016-17 curriculum changes. The number of credits at Franklin may decrease effective fall 2016 allowing students to transfer in more credit from FVTC.

**There is some flexibility in choosing which additional courses to take at FVTC and which courses to take at Franklin. For example, a student could choose to take Marketing Management at FVTC to MKTG 300 at Franklin instead of taking Supervision at FVTC and transferring it in. There are several courses listed in the “take at Franklin” section that can be taken at FVTC, however, students have to meet our residency requirement (currently 40 credits), so it’s best they take courses they need rather than more electives.

*** Students need a total of 124 credits to earn their bachelor’s degree AND to complete specified courses, so even though students will receive 86 credits for their transfer from FVTC, only 84 can/will be applied towards their specified requirements with Franklin.
