ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Open to any FVTC student who:

- A) Successfully completes all courses in the program at FVTC with a grade of C- or better in each course, and
- B) Meets the CUW admission requirements for transfer students into the Construction and Trades Management program, with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater for full acceptance. Or with a GPA <2.0, a candidate may appeal by submitting an essay and interview to explain why they should be admitted as junior status on a conditional basis.

Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended must be sent directly to the CUW Center at which the student is enrolling.
