**Franklin University Transfer Notes:**

Students must complete at least 40 credits at Franklin University for residency to receive a Bachelors Degree from Franklin University.

Students must complete a minimum of 124 credits in order to complete the minimum credit requirement for the Bachelors of Science - Nursing from Franklin University.

Laboratory component needed for at least 1 science course.

For the Social Sciences requirement, students must take courses in at least 2 separate disciplines.

Both General Education and University Electives must be non-developmental.

A maximum of 8 credit hours of Franklin University MBA courses can be completed in as University Electives.

Transfer credit hour minimum for a 4 hour Franklin course is 2.67 semester hours. The difference in transferred credit and Franklin course credit must be made up in the General Education Elective and/or University elective sections.

For Math beyond Intermediate Algebra requirement, student may select from College Algebra, Calculus or Finite Mathematics.

Student must meet Algebra Competency requirement.
